Tonights' Game

For the third straight day the Tornadoes will look for their second win of the series as they start a reliever against the Gary South Shore Railcats. Chris Torres will make his first start on the mound after 26 prior relief appearances. The right hander was drafted as a pitcher by the Pittsburgh Pirates in 2001 but didn't sign and started his career in 2005 as a catcher after being drafted by the Detroit Tigers.

On the other side, Stephen Hiscock will make his ninth start of the season when he is activated off the DL this afternoon. The Waterbury, Connecticut native spent two years in the Tampa Bay Rays system before joining Gary SouthShore this offseason.

Edmondson On Record Pace

After a two home run, three RBI performance Saturday night, Jerod Edmondson has a chance to put together a career year. The Tornadoes center fielder has 10 home runs, 39 RBI, 15 doubles and 11 steals in just over half a season. In his first five professional season, Edmondson's career highs have been: 17 home runs, 61 RBI, 28 doubles and 23 stolen bases.

Torres Theatrics

Chris Torres hit a game-tying two run blast off of the interstate last night in the eight inning to tie the game at 5. Of his seven home runs this year, five have come in the final three innings of games, including a game-winner.

Roxanne, Don't Give Me The Red Light

The GarySouthShore RailCats aren't known for their pop (just 17 home runs on the season) but the team has more than made up for it with their base running prowess. Greg Tagert's squad has swiped a league-high 109 bases in 138 attempts and they've been busy in this series. Gary South-Shore has stolen seven bases in 10 attempts, including four last night.

Successful Debuts

The Tornadoes have had three position players make their professional debuts over the course of the first three games of the series. Each player reached base at least once, as Kyle Nisson (Quinnipiac) had the game-winning hit by pitch Thursday, Mike Samela (Amherst College) went 1-for-3 and scored a run Friday and Cam Kneeland finished 1-for-3 last night.

Ryan Babineau's Power Surge

After hitting 0 home runs and driving in just four RBI in his first 31 games, Babineau has hit 2 game-winning home runs and driven in 5 RBI in the past two games to lead Gary SouthShore to two victories.
